While we originally planned to send it with our Christmas card earlier this month, but unexpected delays prevented us from including it on time.

Even so, this moment is a perfect opportunity to thank you for your partnership with us over the past year. Your support has been vital in helping us move closer to making *Vision 100* a reality. By God's grace, we've added new chaplains to our team and launched new ministries across North Carolina. Our mission is to blanket the state with God-fearing, Bible-believing, Jesus-following chaplains who build meaningful relationships, earn trust, and share the lifechanging good news of Jesus Christ in a compassionate and non-threatening way. We couldn't do this without you!

To continue growing, we recognize the need to expand both our chaplain team and our administrative support. Ralph and I spend much of our time managing administrative tasks— maintaining our certification program, recruiting new chaplains, and connecting with public safety agencies about chaplaincy. As our ministry grows, so does the workload. At our recent banquet, I shared our goal of raising \$50,000 in new donations to fund two part-time administrative positions. These roles will be vital to sustaining and supporting our growth.

We cannot fulfill God's calling without the partnership of His people. I want to ask you to prayerfully consider joining us in funding these positions.
